Construction Site Safety Professional Training

Starting in December 2014 the AGC of SD will be offering a new series of safety leadership classes from the National Center for Construction Education & Research (NCCER). The classes listed on this sheet can be taken as stand-alone or compiled to meet the needs of your company.

Construction Site Safety Program (CSSP)

For those wanting more the classes can be taken in series as part of NCCER's CSSP. The tiered structure of the CSSP offers four levels of safety certification. The levels are as follows:

- Construction Site Safety Master Instructor (CSSM)
- Construction Site Safety Technician (CSST)
- Construction Site Safety Supervisor (CSSS)
- Construction Site Safety Orientation (CSSO)

Instructor Certification Training Program (ICTP)

The ICTP is a course for project managers, supervisors, foreman and others who lead or train in your organization. Subjects covered in the ICTP include the following:

- How Learning Occurs
- Communication for Learning
- Leadership and Group Dynamics
- Administration and Classroom Management
- Teaching Strategies

Everyone pursuing certification as part of the CSSP must attend the ICTP and have an OSHA 500 or NCCER Field Safety credential. Field Safety is a 4 day class that is being offered in conjunction with an OSHA 30 hr class January 8,15,22, 29 in Sioux Falls and February 5, 12, 19, 26 in Rapid City.

NCCER Safety Technology

Safety Technology provides instruction on how to implement and administer a company's safety program. This training is designed for project managers, supervisors and safety directors. The modules included in Safety Technology are listed on the back of this sheet.
