Ranking Criteria includes: Experience, last performance evaluations, quality of past work, personnel qualifications, ability to perform work within time constraints, organization, local presence and SD professional licensure. The SDDOT reserves the right to solicit proposals from only those consultants that demonstrate required qualifications and experience. Each firm chosen will be furnished information upon which to base proposals. The SDDOT will afford equal opportunity to all those who submit statements of interest and will not discriminate in its selection of consultants on the grounds of race, sex, color, disability or national origin.
