The Build Dakota Scholarship Fund was established to assist in overcoming the workforce shortage facing South Dakota. The original \$50 million fund continues to make a significant impact by providing students with training in high-need workforce areas. In return for the full-ride scholarship, scholars agree to work in South Dakota for 36 months following graduation.

Extending the benefits of the Build Dakota Scholarship means reaching out to industry partners. It's the reason why we're traveling to local communities: to bring this transformative opportunity to students, parents, technical institutes and employers across the entire state. By participating in an industry partner program, students receive a full-ride scholarship, businesses gain skilled employees and Build Dakota is able to launch more skilled scholars into the workforce.
